Bending the Cost Curve

Additionally:

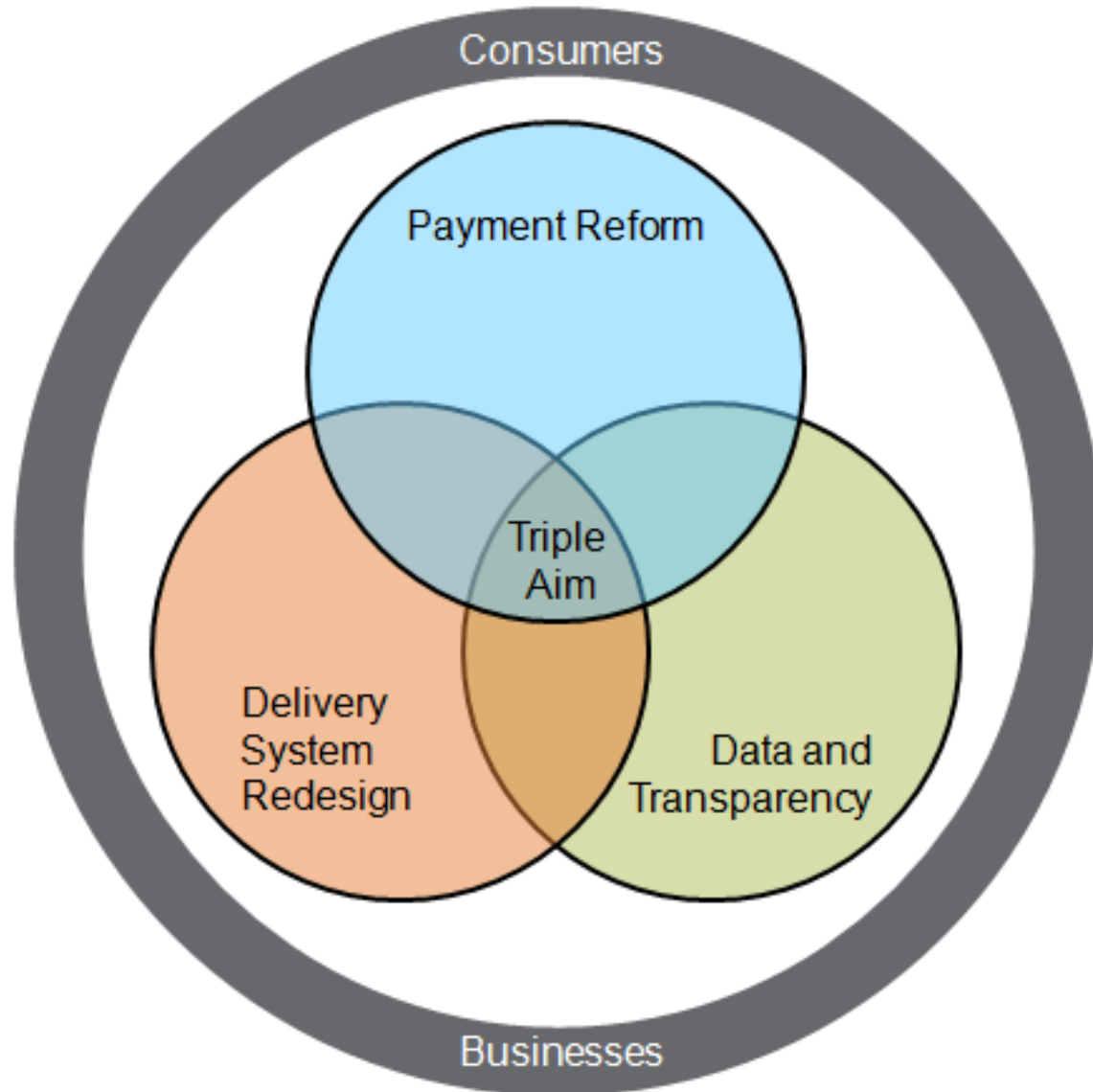
- Reduce variability of cost across Colorado

Building the Statewide HIE Network

- Including: EMPI, safety/security protections, QHN connection, governing policies and procedures etc.

CO Health Insurance Exchange

- 9-Member Oversight Board Appointed
 - Now Activated - held first Meeting
 - Operational Leadership in Place
 - Four main work groups
 - Data Analysis, Simulations, Demographics
 - Small Employers Focus
 - IT Solutions (verify and track eligibility)
 - Marketing, Education and Outreach
- Jan 1, 2013 Deadline for Federal Certification
